



Alberta Golf Covid-19 Policies

March 31, 2021

As a participant in Alberta Golf events, I have read and understood the Alberta Golf Event Procedures as stated below. Participants include players, staff, volunteers.

EVENT PRE-ARRIVAL

- Event Waiver and Release must be agreed to at the time of event registration
- Check albertagolf.org for updates or notifications
- If applicable, read all tournament regulations including Notice to Competitors

CLUB FACILITIES & AMENITIES

- The availability for participants to access the clubhouse, pro-shop and on-course rest rooms will be provided to all participants by electronic means
- Participants must adhere to each host club's regulations in terms of access to facilities
- Participants are responsible for their own equipment at all times

ARRIVAL AND PREPARATION

- A greeter will be present to provide directions and screen all participants
- Only registered participants are eligible to be onsite. Caddies and spectators are not allowed
- Players will be informed of all safety protocols in place in the event of inclement weather

PREVENT THE SPREAD

- To protect yourself and others: practice physical distancing; wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer; cover coughs and sneezes with a tissue or your elbow; avoid touching your face with unwashed hands; watch for COVID-19 symptoms: cough, fever, shortness of breath, runny nose or sore throat
- Covid – 19 can be transmitted by asymptomatic people and accordingly the statements made by participants contained in this document cannot provide certainty that the virus will not be transmitted. Alberta Golf is taking prudent steps to impose and enforce appropriate protocols to keep participants, family members, volunteers and club staff safe, but there can be no assurances that the virus will not be contracted by others. This is a risk that each participant must assess themselves, and if they choose to participate, takes the risk of either contracting the virus or transmitting it to others.
- I hereby declare that neither I nor anyone in my household has experienced any cold or flu-like symptoms in the last 14 days (to include fever, cough, sore throat, respiratory illness, difficulty breathing or stomach cramps). If I or anyone in my household has experienced any cold or flu-like symptoms after submitting this declaration, I will then withdraw from the current event and any other events I am registered to attend within a 14-day period of time. This declaration will remain in effect until Alberta Golf declares the requirements in this declaration are no longer in effect.
- I hereby declare that I or any member of my household have not traveled to or had a lay-over in any country outside of Canada in the past 14 days. If I or anyone in my household travel to any country outside Canada after submitting this declaration, I will withdraw from the current event and any other event I am registered to attend for a minimum period of 14 days after date of return to Canada. This agreement will remain in effect until Alberta Golf declares the requirements in this declaration are no longer in effect.

Alberta Golf Event Waiver and Release *(Covid-19 guidelines)*

March 31, 2021

This Event Waiver and Release must be read and agreed to prior to registering and participating in any Alberta Golf event. Failure to do so will result in the participant's inability to attend or participate in any championship or event.

1. By agreeing to this waiver, I confirm that I am the individual whose application is being submitted, and that I have read and understood this waiver and release.
2. For applicants under the age of 18, the parent and/or legal guardian certifies the information contained within this entry is true, that they are aware of the applicant's intention to participate in this championship(s), and that the applicant does so with their approval and consent.
3. I understand this waiver and release is made for the benefit of Alberta Golf, and each of its directors, officers, employees, volunteers, coaches, referees, business operators, agents and site property owners or occupiers (collectively, the "Organization").
4. I understand there are inherent risks associated with each of the following activities:
 - The game of golf
 - The use of golf equipment and/or power carts, whether rented or purchased from the Organization, or on my own
 - The use of the Organization's facilities
 - Participation in sport, fitness, instruction, food and beverage services, and other activities, services, programs or events provided or organized by the Organization.
5. I am aware that the risks include, but are not limited to, the potential for serious personal injury, death or property damage. I understand the risks may be relative to my own state of fitness and health (including physical, mental and emotional), and to the awareness, care and skill with which I conduct myself.
6. I freely accept and fully assume all responsibility for all risks and possibilities of personal injury, death, property damage and other loss resulting from my participation in the above described activities. I accept these risks and agree to the terms of this waiver and release, even if the Organization is found to be negligent or in breach of any duty of care or any obligation to me in my participation in the activities.
7. In addition to consideration given to the Organization for my participation in activities, I and my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators and assigns (collectively my "legal Representatives"), agree:
 - a. To waive all claims that I have or may have in the future against the Organization;
 - b. To release and forever discharge the Organization from all liability for all personal injury, death, property damage or other loss resulting from my participation in the above described activities due to any cause, including but not limited to negligence (failure to use such care as a reasonably prudent and careful person would use under similar circumstances) either passive or active, breach of any duty imposed by law, breach of contract or mistake or error of judgment of the Organization;
 - c. To release and forever discharge the Organization from all liability for all personal injury, property damage or other loss resulting from any infectious disease, virus, bacterium, or other microorganism (whether asymptomatic or not); or
 - d. To release and forever discharge the Organization from all liability for all personal injury, death, property damage or other loss resulting from Coronavirus (COVID – 19) including any mutation or variation thereof; or



- e. To release and forever discharge the Organization from all liability for all personal injury, death, property damage or other loss resulting from a pandemic or epidemic, as declared as such by the World Health Organization and any government authority; and
 - f. To be liable for and to hold harmless and indemnify the Organization from all actions, proceedings, claims, damages, costs, demands including court costs and costs on a solicitor and client basis, and liabilities of whatsoever nature or kind arising out of or in any way connected with my participation in activities.
8. I understand and agree to the following:
- a. The responsibility to read and understand how each of the Organization's competition or event policies apply to this specific event;
 - b. To abide by local, provincial, or federal safety protocols, including practicing 'physical distancing' in defense and mitigation of Covid – 19; and
 - c. To receive email messages from the Organization, relating to events.
9. In case of a medical emergency during the event, I authorize a qualified medical doctor to take all necessary measures in the treatment of this applicant.
10. I agree that this Waiver and Release and all terms contained within are governed by the laws of the Alberta. I hereby irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Alberta. Any litigation to enforce this Waiver and Release must be instituted in Alberta.
11. I confirm that I have had sufficient time to read and understand each term in this Waiver and Release in its entirety and have agreed to the terms freely and voluntarily. I understand that this Waiver and Release is binding on myself and my Legal Representatives.
