**Doug Silverberg**

A dominant force on the Alberta golf scene since the late 1940s, Doug Silverberg won every major provincial championship in his home province including the Juvenile, Junior, Amateur, Open and Match Play.

In addition to his stellar provincial record, Doug won the Canadian Junior Championship in 1950 and the Canadian Senior Championship in 1994. He also represented Canada several times at the Commonwealth Tournaments, Americas Cup and World Amateur Team Championship.
