



Alberta Golf Hall of Fame – Distinguished Service Tony Krivoblocki

Tony Krivoblocki joined the Calgary Golf Association in 1971 when it was a struggling organization with only twelve member clubs and a roster of just four tournaments. As a board member over the next thirty-six years – thirty as either president or vice president – he would catalyze the growth of the organization to thirty-six clubs hosting ten major tournaments each year. Tony was involved in every aspect of each event from receiving entries, making draws, starting players, adjudicating the Rules of Golf, scoring, liaising with the media and promoting the association.

During his tenure with the CGA he was also actively involved with his home club, the Silver Springs Golf and Country Club, as Club Captain, Director and President.

Tony's goal has been to build competitive golf in Calgary and has selflessly dedicated countless hours to successfully achieving that objective. His legacy lives



on as Calgary is now known nationally for its depth of talented players and its competitive golf scene.
